The concept of the Sunbeam 32.1 is a weekend sailer that is based on the modern-day lifestyle.

The SUNBEAM 32.1 not only provides first class sailing due to the special features, the yacht and its concept is also unique as a private retreat for weekends with the family, or as a floating home office. The “wave piercer bow” and the “flight deck” are the main design features of this innovative yacht.

The SUNBEAM 32.1 maximizes the usable deck space, offering significantly more space on deck and below deck compared to other yachts.

Our innovative “One-Level-Cockpit” with comfortable, wide seating and lounging



areas, in combination with very easy handling, are further striking advantages of the new Weekend Sailer concept.

The bathing platform at the stern can be extended and retracted electronically and has an integrated bathing ladder. When extended, an approx. 4 m² sun deck without steps or edges opens up behind the two steering wheels.

The good stability and high ballast of the yacht ensure safety when sailing. In addition, the carefully arranged fittings allow single-handed sailing.

Smart innovation and sustainability



Sustainability is a central theme in our society and especially important in the world of modern product development.

For us, this means keeping the ecological footprint of the SUNBEAM 32.1 as small as possible. Instead of using teak on deck, we rely on a 100 % recyclable material – Resysta. This consists of approximately 60 % rice husks, 22 % rock salt and approximately 18 % mineral oil. It is extremely weather-resistant, UV-resistant and color-fast. Compared to a teak deck, this also noticeably minimizes the maintenance effort required.



Deck highlights

The deck is wider at the bow than the hull. This not only maximizes the usable deck space, but also serves as an integrated bowsprit. Access from the front is simple and easy. The aim was to reflect the freedom of movement of a 40-foot boat onto a 32-foot boat.



We put a lot of emphasis on a clean deck. This was realized with the “X-Brace”, which functions as a canopy, halyard cover and aero element.



The SUNBEAM 32.1 breaks many traditions and has what it takes to be a trendsetter. Bold and fresh – a yacht for anyone who is looking for the extraordinary.



To enhance the overall family experience and the enjoyment of every passenger, there has to be something for everyone on board – not just those behind the wheel. That is why it was necessary to create more than one experience zone on the yacht: In addition to the electronically extendable bathing platform, which lengthens the boat considerably more than industry-standard solutions and at the same time generates a continuous area in the cockpit (flush), the wide foredeck offers plenty of space for fun activities.

Highlights below deck



The interior follows the same philosophy as the exterior. That means: Making the available space tangible. The elimination of bulkhead walls and mini-cabins breaks up the confinement found in conventional yachts, and creates a bright, wide and modern space that is a pleasure to spend time in.



For the first time at SUNBEAM, we installed a complete intelligent bus system. It can be controlled via smart devices and/or an app. We call this "Smart Sunbeam". It includes simple and seamless monitoring of the most important components and systems on the yacht. This allows the owner to concentrate on the essentials: the joy of sailing.

The SUNBEAM 32.1 has not only been completely rethought in terms of design – its technical equipment also meets the requirements of today and has been re-designed from the ground up.

That is why the SUNBEAM 32.1 is offered in three different types of keel: a deep keel (180 cm), a short keel (130 cm) and for the first time a twin keel variant (130 cm), a torpedo keel, whereby the rudders of the bilge keel version have small winglets to avoid sinking into the bottom mud.
